## SPJ & St. Paul North Canton to Team Up to Help Haitian Youth

On April 10<sup>th</sup>, SPJ students will travel to St. Paul North Canton; there, we will be creating care packages for the children of Haiti. This effort is taking place in support of



an organization called "Leena's Ladybugs." Lenna's Ladybugs is an organization dedicated to clothing the children of the world. The organization started in October of 2012 after the death of Lenna Moser, a special friend to the organization. After visiting Haiti, she developed a huge heart for the children. After her passing, her Bible study decided to honor her memory by developing this organization. They began making t-shirts to send little girls in Haiti. Since then, they added packages with other clothing items. One of their special items is a dress that contains a Ladybug button on the left shoulder. In the fall of 2013, they began collecting items for boys. As of March 2017, they have sent over 2,800 dress packages and 1,146 packages to missions in Haiti, and several other countries.



SPJ has been asked to collect coloring books and crayons to include in the care packages that we'll be putting together.
