Things we collect at SPJ

	Box Tops for Education	Each one of these little box tops is worth \$0.10 for the school. We get double from the box tops people twice a year for all of the box tops we submit to them!
	Ink Cartridges	Cartridges of all sizes and shapes, empty or unused, are collected; we receive varying amounts for each cartridge that is collected.
	ACME Grocery Receipts	ACME Grocery receipts within the dates of August 16, 2017 – December 31, 2017 are collected. We receive 3% of the "Community Cashback" total on the bottom of each receipt. It really adds up!
	Old Cell Phones	If you have old cell phones sitting around in drawers, send them in to be recycled; we receive varying amounts for each recycled phone.
	Campbell's Labels	This program is almost done with its run; if you still have labels with the "Labels for Education" logo on them, they can be submitted through Christmas break; the program ends for good on January 2, 2018.
	Mid's Lids	We collect the lids from Mid's pasta sauce jars. They can be submitted to the company for reimbursement.
	Old Cords	Old cords used for appliances, cell phones, computers, video games, and many more can be turned in for recycling – the metals inside them have value!

Holy Cross Academy Substitute Teaching

Are you interested in substitute teaching for Holy Cross Catholic Schools? We are seeking candidates who are interested in this rewarding work in our Catholic school communities! In order to substitute in any of our nine elementary schools individuals must attend a 2 hour orientation at the HC office, complete a background check and Virtus Child Protection training, and shadow a teacher in a Holy Cross School(s) for up to two days. In addition, a long or short term substitute license must be obtained through the Ohio Department of Education. A short term substitute license can be obtained with a four year college degree in any concentration.
