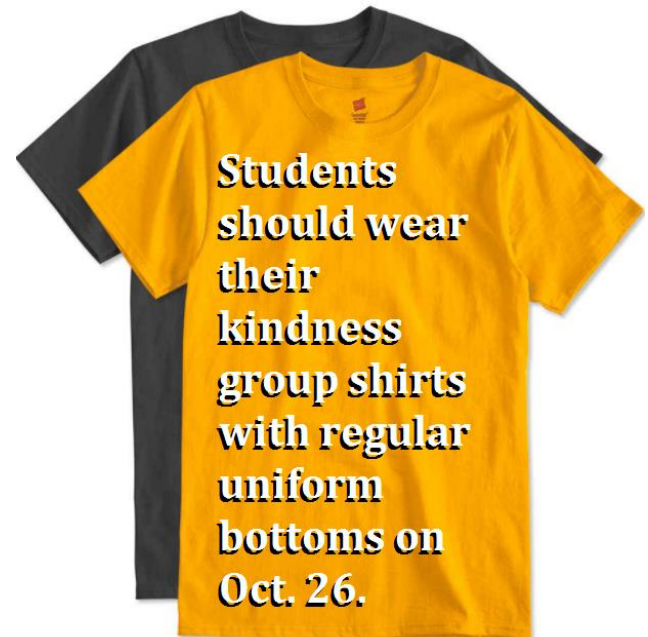
Night at the Races – Nov. 3
