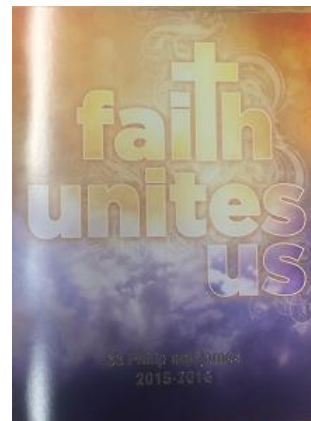
MORNING DROP OFF
