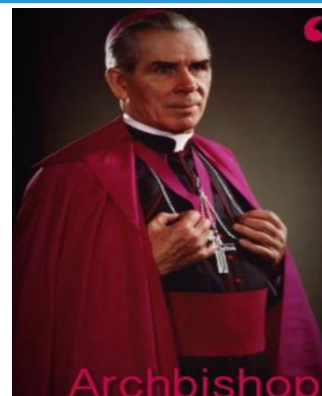
SKI CLUB 2017-2018
